A huge well done to our Y5 & Y6 football teams for not giving up and playing their hearts out despite results not going their way! Super resilience and determination—Well done!








Year 2 walked around the local area around school recently. They were observing human and physical features as part of their Geography topic.


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Year 2 have also been investigating 3D shapes—edges, faces and vertices!

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Reception enjoyed their visit from Animal Story this week! They were excited to handle a variety of creatures and some were even brave enough to hold a snake!









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
Year 4 have had an an explosive time today! They worked really hard at home on their volcano projects!
