


Stockton Children's Book of the Year 2024

We were so proud of Ava and Thomas in Year 5, who were our winners at Stocktonchildren's Book of the Year and were presented their award by the Mayor of Stockton.









Nursery have been learning about Spring and Easter. They have been looking for signs of spring, learning about hatching eggs and completing craft activities!






